





# Scotland Malawi Geography round

**Higher!**




Loch Morar is the deepest freshwater body in the British Isles with a **maximum depth of 310m**. The loch has a surface elevation of **9m** above sea level.  $9 - 310 = -301m$  relative to sea level

The surface of Lake Malawi is located at **474m above sea level**, with a **maximum depth of 706m**.  $474 - 706 = -232m$  relative to sea level
