

# Who was David Livingstone?

- Missionary, doctor, campaigner, explorer, celebrity.
- Born in Blantyre, Scotland in 1813.
- Travelled to Southern Africa as Christian medical missionary.
- Author of Victorian bestseller '*Missionary Travels.*'
- Abolitionist critical of the East African Slave Trade.

# Learning and Engagement: School Workshops



## 'Learning from Livingstone: Classroom activities from David Livingstone Birthplace Museum through an anti-racist critical lens.'

Learners will:

- Discuss how racism has played a role in what history is taught.

- Learn about and investigate this history in a way that amplifies under-represented African individuals' perspectives and stories.
- Reflect on positionality, privilege and power, and be supported to unlearn unconscious bias, prejudice, and divisiveness.
