


BACKGROUND TO THE MOTHER'S DAY FUN RUN

Mother's Day Fun Run is a Corporate Social Responsibility project of Nation Publications Limited dedicated to the cause of safe motherhood since 2005.

The following district hospitals have so far benefited from the project including Queen Elizabeth Central Hospital, Bwaila Hospital, Mzuzu Health Centre, Zomba Central Hospital, Dedza District Hospital, Karonga District Hospital, Thyolo District Hospital, Nkhotakota District Hospital, Rumphi District Hospital and Mangochi District Hospital.

The Mother's Day Fun Run project enables NPL, organisations and individuals to directly contribute towards achievement of Millennium Development Goal number 5 to "improve maternal health".
